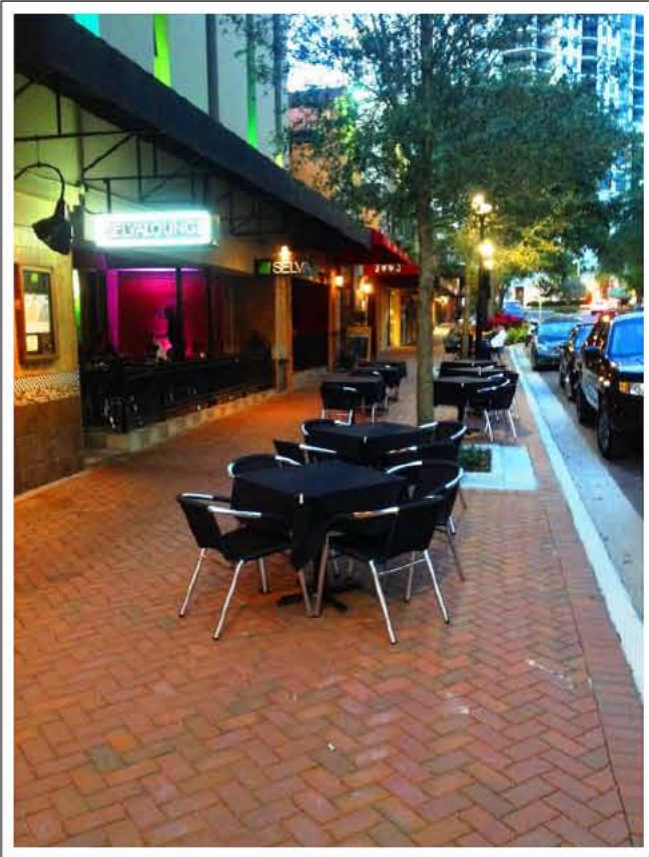

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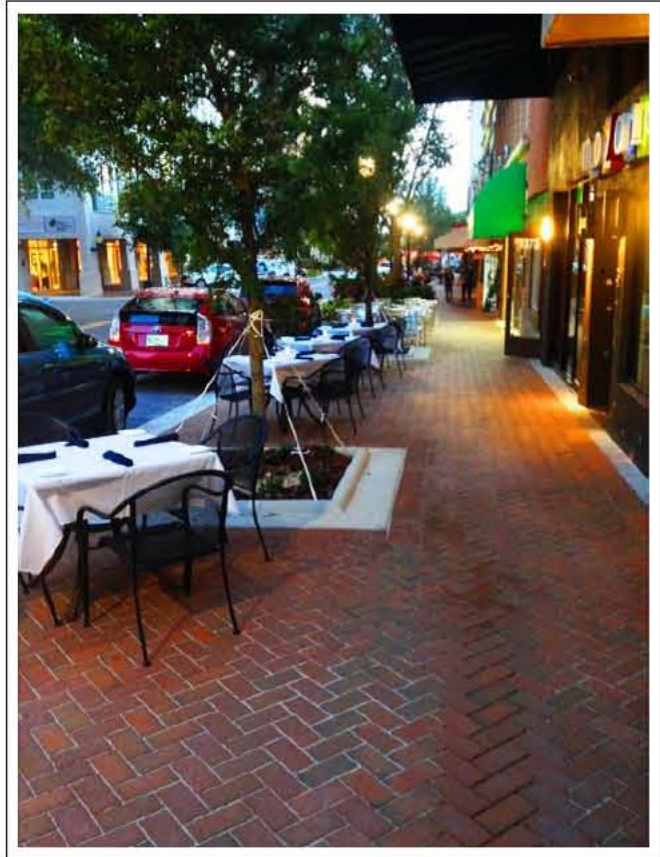
COMPLETED ON-TIME!

Superb performance by Jon F. Swift, Inc. and its subcontractors Gulf Breeze Landscape, Brick Pavers, Inc., IDA Irrigation Design Associates and consultants DWJA Landscape Architects and Cavoli Engineering finished the DID's \$1,900,000 Main Street Streetscape Improvement project on schedule. Pats-on-the-back also go to the City's Chief Planner Steve Stancel who managed the design and the City's Project Manager Richard Winder who coordinated the construction.

This project was sandwiched between two parades with no room to spare – the Boat Parade on July 4 and the Veteran's Day Parade on November 11. The sidewalks are wider, beautifully bricked and landscaped for more pedestrian comfort and outside dining. Check out the album of images below.
